Pass EDA has announced its first event of the year, a Regional City Manager Forum to be held Wednesday, September 26 at 7:30 am at Tukwet Canyon Golf Course. The cost of the event is \$25.00 per person and includes breakfast.

The City Managers of Yucaipa, Calimesa, and Beaumont, as well as the Acting City Manager of Banning, will talk about their cities' efforts to recruit businesses to the region and the current status of their cities. The forum will be followed by a question and answer session.

Pass EDA (Economic Development Agency) has sponsored a similar event in past years, and is pleased to resume events important to our communities again.
